Title: The Search for Tutankhamen Non-fiction
Stage 1

Text type: Recount

| Key teaching objectives | Children will be able to: |

Preparation

Before starting this Guided Reading session, you should ensure the children:

- have already been introduced to the Search for Tutankhamen through a Shared Reading session in Unit 2 of the Literacy Lesson Non-Fiction Teacher's Guide (Stage 1).
- have completed the Before Reading section on the pupil card overleaf.

Guided Reading

Introduction

- Refer to the Before Reading activity, reminding the children that they have made notes about how pictures and photos help them to remember details about Tutankhamen.
- Model using an index to look up a specific piece of information, and read it aloud to the group. Discuss all the things you found out. Draw attention to key words, illustrations and phrases that helped you. Show the children how to note these down.

Independent Reading

- Ask each child to use the index and select entries to look up.
- Ask them to read quietly to themselves and look closely at the pictures or photos.
- After ten minutes, ask them to stop and to note down or discuss new things they have learned from their reading.

Evaluation and Analysis

Activity 1

- Ask the children whether the book gave them the information they thought it would. Were they surprised by anything they read?

Activity 2

- Talk about the facts they have learned while reading.

Follow-up Activities

The children can complete the After Reading section on the pupil card overleaf.
